MATCHING FUNGICIDES TO VARIETIES


Varieties differ massively in the way they respond to fungicide inputs. Traditionally, very high-yielding crops responded most to fungicide inputs. However, now some high-yielding crops require much less fungicide input than others.

How much to spend?


The 'responsiveness' of a variety is a good starting point – on average, how much yield response do you get from a fungicide programme?

The chart shows how varieties respond to fungicide inputs. Those in green are low to medium response varieties and those in pink or orange are high or very high response varieties.
